We understand how difficult and frustrating it can be to bring your cat to the hospital. In an effort to make things easier for your feline companion, at least once they get to Patton Veterinary Hospital, we have made some changes. We have created a feline friendly waiting area in the lobby for cats only to try to limit dogs from sniffing and bothering them while in their carrier. Room 4, the furthest exam room from the lobby, has been designated our Cat Room. This room is quieter so your cat feels less stressed from barking dogs and the normal daily activities. We have placed non-slip mats and towels on the exam tables to make them feel secure and not let their sensitive feet stand on the cold metal table. Feliway spray is available in this room to help provide anti-anxiety feelings. Changes have even been made in the in-patient ward as well. For cats staying in the hospital, we provide towels for them to sleep comfortably on and boxes where they can hide and feel safe. We hope that the changes we are making will help your cat feel more comfortable while at Patton Veterinary Hospital and cause less stress for you as well.
