

GENERAL BOARDING INFORMATION

We are very happy that you have chosen to board with the Patton Veterinary Hospital. To allow our animal care staff the time to properly care for each patient within our facility we suggest the following times for admission and discharge:

Weekdays 10am - 6pm
Saturdays 10am – 1pm
Sundays 6pm-7pm

Scheduling admission and discharge times will allow the animal care staff to prepare for you and your companion and assure a timely and organized check in or out. Please inform the client relations team upon admit of the day and time you will be picking up your companion.

We are closed for admission and discharges on all major holidays and 1pm – 3pm on Thursdays, and also the first Tuesday of every month from 1pm – 3pm for staff meetings and educational seminars.

Our goal is to provide your companion with the most complete care possible while in our facility. **Please allow for 15 minutes or more, depending on your companion's needs to complete the admit process. By completing the attached form we will be able to complete the process in a more efficient manner.** At the time of admission a nurse will go over the history of the patient and ensure all information is accurate. For your pet's safety, in the event that he/she does not eat while they are here, we will perform a glucose check to ensure the pet's sugar levels are appropriate. This will be done by the supervising attending doctor. These charges are not included in regular diabetic boarding and will only be performed if necessary. Thank you for your time and for allowing us to care for your companion.

BOARDING RATES

Boarding for Diabetics: \$32.00 per day (medication/supplies are provided by owner)
Insulin syringes are: \$1.10 per day (if owner did not provide)

All guests are charged for the day of check-in regardless of arrival time. If check-out occurs before noon, there is no charge for that day. For the safety of your companion, and all others in our care, we require that all boarding animals are current on all vaccinations. Current bordetella vaccination is required for all dogs and a negative feline leukemia test for cats.
